

Annual Meeting of Bellamy Manor estates Civic League - December 7, 2019 - 12:15 pm - Kempsville Public Library (12 in attendance)

* Heather Brinkershoff called the meeting to order and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

* The minutes of the 2018 Annual Meeting (posted on the Civic League's website) were approved.

* Becky Fenska reviewed the Proposed (\$ 2,525) and Actual (4 1810.71) Budget for 2019 and presented a proposed budget for 2020 of \$ 2500. Most line items were the same as last year with some slight variations. The Proposed Budget for 2020 was adopted unanimously by those present.

* Five BMECL Committee Reports were provided which included a) Flags and Flyers - which posted flags on 3 patriotic holidays (Memorial Day, 4th of July & Veterans' Day) and delivered 4 quarterly newsletters. b) The Outreach Committee - which provided 175 Beach Bags to children at Providence Elementary School. c) The Social Committee which sponsored the first "Coffee in the Court" in June and reported increased attendance at the annual Halloween Block Party in October. d) The Welcoming Committee which welcomed 19 new families to the neighborhood. e) The Yard of the Month Committee which awarded 6 different households (April-October), with plans to honor "Holiday Lights" in December.

* In ensuing discussion more Coffee in the Courts was encouraged, perhaps as many as four; and a watermelon social was considered. Problems surrounding rats and squirrels were discussed but no action taken.
